Technical Theatre (New Amsterdam Theater on 42nd St)

Acting Techniques

Students will be given short scenes from various musicals to work on by learning how to break down a scene, assign intentions to characters, create an overall objective, and then perform the scene with feedback by a professional West End director.

Script Writing

Students will put their ideas to paper by learning how to formulate a scene, craft characters, develop a plot, and create their own short work to share with fellow students.

Character Studies

Students will create characters from connecting the body and mind. Using breathing techniques, movement exercises and improvisational skills, they will learn to create a brand-new character and to develop their movement, voice, and intentions.
